



## **PRIMARY PE & SPORT PREMIUM 2014 -2018**

The PE and Sport Premium is designed to help schools, with primary aged pupils, improve the quality of the PE and Sports activities they offer their pupils. The Government spent over £450 million on this funding over the three academic years 2013 – 2016. It has recently doubled the amount given to Primary Schools for the academic year 2017-2018.

The tables below outlines the key areas where the Sport Premium has been used to improve the provision of Sport and PE for our pupils during the Academic Years 2014 – 2018:
