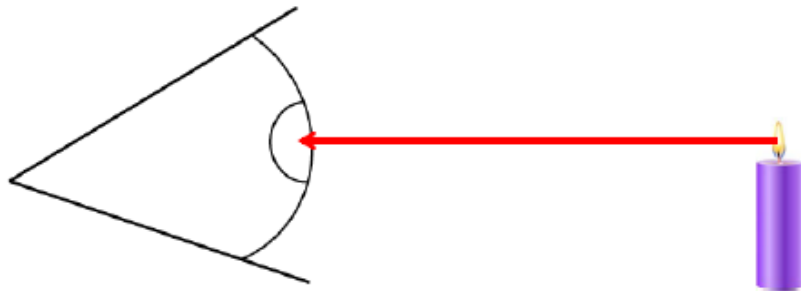
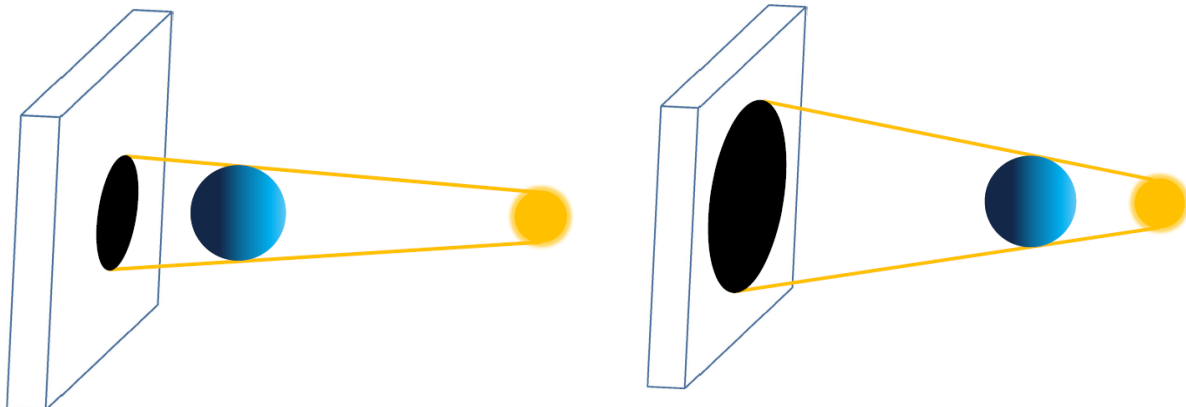


Year 5: Light

- We see things when light enters the eye.



- Light travels in straight lines.
- Shiny objects reflect lots of light.
- Dull objects absorb lots of light.
- Shadows are made by opaque objects blocking the light
- The closer the object to the light source the bigger the shadow.



Keywords

Opaque: a material that allows no light to pass through it.

Reflection: when light bounces off a surface.

Translucent: a material that allows some light to pass through it.

Transparent: a material that allows all light to pass through it.
