Industrial Revolution	Britain's industry changes from farming to factories
Sanitation	Running water and flushing toilets
Invention	The action of creating something like a device
Cause	A reason why something happens
Consequence	What happens after an event takes place
Population growth	The number of people in the country gets bigger
Factory	A big building where lots of people make things
Cholera	A horrible disease many people suffered with in industrial towns caused by drinking dirty water
Empire	A group of countries or states ruled over by another
Technology	Machinery and equipment developed using scientific knowledge
Suffragette	A woman seeking the right to vote through protest
Urbanisation	The gradual increase in the proportion of people living in urban areas.
Slum	A very overcrowded and dirty place, many factory workers lived in places like this during the Industrial Revolution.

Assessment: City Life During the Mid 1800s - source work

Britain during 17508

- 80% of people worked in the countryside. London was the only city with more than 10,000 people.
- The triangular trade in enslaved Africans was at its height. Sugar, tobacco and cotton plantations in the Caribbean and North America were bringing huge profits to Britain's businesses and banks. Some of this was invented in entrepreneurs and inventors at the time of the Industrial Revolution.
- Only a few wealthy men could vote and CofE religion was very important.
