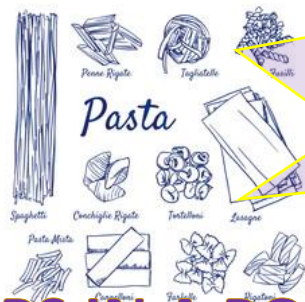

EVALUATIONS AND SENSORY ANALYSIS

Appearance: flat, bright, burnt, cloudy, colourful, crunchy, dull, even, lumpy, patterned, smooth, undercooked, watery.
