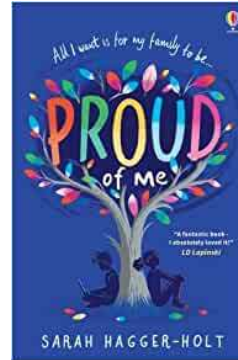


The Little Rebel Children's Book Award 2022

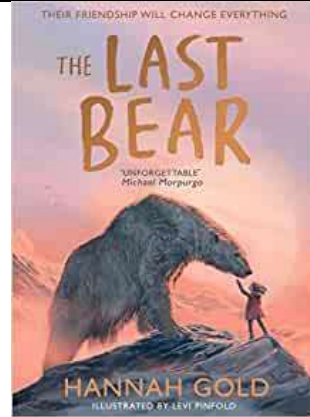


Waterstones Children's Book Prize 2022



An annual award first awarded in 2005, the purpose of the prize is "to uncover hidden talent in children's writing" and is therefore open only to authors who have published no more than three books.

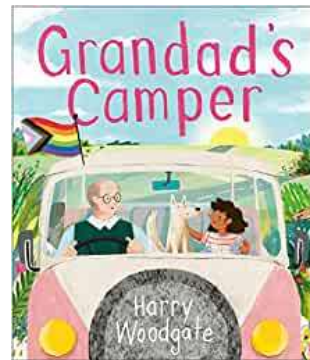
