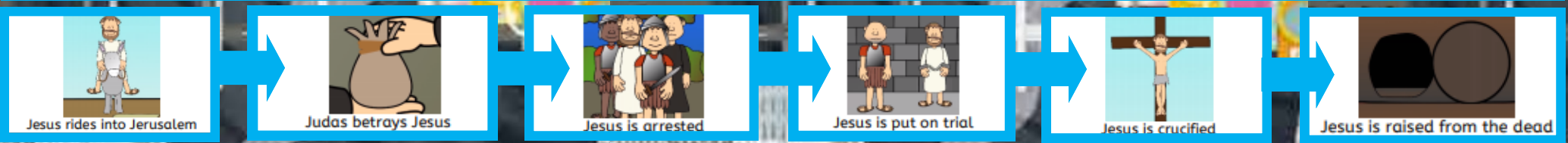


# Y5 SALVATION: What did Jesus do to save human beings?
