Year 5 "How does life begin?"

- > Differences between male and female
- Correct naming of body parts
- Creating a baby
- Birth of a baby

Year 6 "Puberty - body changes"

- Physical changes in boys / girls
- Menstruation and personal hygiene

Topics will be covered in single-sex groups and resources provided by the School Nurses.

Year 7 "Relationships, friendships and responsibilities"

- > Revision / reinforcement of Year 6 work on 'Puberty'
- Emotional changes in puberty / managing emotions
- 'My image and influences on me'
- > Friendships and relationships
- Responsibilities of parenthood

Year 8 "Contraception and risk-taking"

- Why young people have sexual relationships and whether their decisions are right
- Methods of contraception (a chance for children to see and handle resources)
- > Safety / risk-taking / responsibility in sexual relationships

Topics will be covered in mixed groups and resources provided by the School Nurses.
