

Words ending in ‘-able’. If this is being added to a root word ending in –ce or –ge then the e after the c or g is kept other wise they would be said with their hard sounds as in cap and gap.	Adverbs of time (temporal adverbs) these are words to develop chronology in writing.	Adding suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words ending in –fer. The r is doubled if the –fer is still stressed when the ending is added. If the –feris not stressed then the r isn’t doubled.	Words with ‘silent’ letters at the start.
