Facts about Hundertwasser


- He was an Austrian artist inspired by nature

- Onion domes feature in his designs with trees that look like lollipops.











Key Vocabulary

Aerial - A viewpoint as seen from above

Concentric - Arcs or shapes that share the same centre.

Complementary Colours - Colours that are opposite to each other on the colour wheel. They are strongly contrasting.

Stippling – small dots
