

Key Words	
A Computer Network	A collection of computer systems connected together to communicate with each other by exchanging data.
Binary	A base 2 number system that only uses 0 or 1 digits
Local Area Network (LAN)	Computers connected together over a small area e.g. a small company or home
Wide Area Network (WAN)	Computers connected over a larger area such as a multinational company
Software	A collection of computer instructions that tell the computer how to work
Hardware	The physical parts of the computer
Pseudo Code	A way of writing instructions but not in a given code format

Binary – It uses Base 2

So $1101 = 8+4+1 = 13$
